Leadership in Strategic Innovation

Professor Victor Cui joined the Asper School of Business of the University of Manitoba in 2012. He obtained his Ph.D. (business administration) from the Sauder School of Business at the University of British Columbia, and Ph.D. (industrial engineering) from the City University of Hong Kong.

His research focuses on internal and external determinants of firms' innovation process and performance. In particular, how innovation is influenced by firms' incentive systems (i.e., compensation structure) and inter-firm relationships (i.e., collaboration and competition). His research appears in top tier academic journals such as **Strategic Management Journal**. He was a winner of the **Best Paper Award** of the Technology and Innovation Management (TIM) Division of the Administrative Sciences Association of Canada in 2011, the **Best Student Paper Award** of the TIM Division of the Academy of Management (AOM) in 2010, and the **Best Student Paper Award** (finalist) of the Human Resource Management Division of the AOM in 2010.

His current teaching interest is strategic management. He was a winner of the **Graduate Teaching Award** of the University of British Columbia in 2009, and was nominated for the **Associates' Teaching Award** of the Asper School of Business in 2013.
