The Academic Review Committee (ARC) assesses engineering applicants who do not hold a Bachelor's Degree from a program accredited by the Canadian Engineering Accreditation Board and the academic background of all geoscientists applying for registration.

The ARC met seven times between July 1, 2008 and June 30, 2009. The Committee considered seven appeals. Five interviews were conducted for applicants who had been assigned confirmatory examinations and who appeared to have more than ten years of appropriate work experience.

During the year, 139 applicants (108 Engineers and 31 Geoscientists) completed the examination programs and were deemed academically qualified.

The assessment of academic qualifications is, by no means, a simple task, and I therefore would like to sincerely thank the ARC members for their participation and service.
