Certified English or French Translation

To have a copy certified, an authorized person must compare the original document to the photocopy and must print the following on the photocopy:

- "I certify that this is a true copy of the original document",
- The name of the original document,
- The date of the certification.
- · Their name,
- · Their official posiiton or title, and
- Their signature.

Degree

A degree is an academic credential, usually earned at a university.

Educational Credential

Any diploma, degree, or trade/apprenticeship credential issued for completing a program of study or training at a recognized educational or training institution.

Eligible

To be eligible for something means to be qualified to participate or be chosen.

Licence

The official document that provides proof of formal permission given by a provincial/territorial engineering/geoscience association to practise engineering or geoscience. You must have a licence to practise engineering or geoscience independently in Canada.

Official Transcripts

The Registrar's Office of an academic institution issues official transcripts of academic activity and achievement.

Professional Member

A professional member is a member who is currently fully registrered in good standing.

Registered

Recognized as a member of a provincial/territorial engineering association.

Svllabus

The syllabus is described as the summary of the topics covered in the subject.

Transcript

An official document similar to a mark sheet issued by your academic institution upon completion of your program that contains a record of the courses you took, your grades in those courses, and degrees you earned.
