

A.P.E.G.M. LEADERSHIP AWARD

PURPOSE

The Leadership Award is intended to recognize outstanding, long-range vision achievement(s) by an individual, usually in an upper management, executive, or governance role. Someone who has directly caused or influenced major engineering or geoscientific works, developments, or contributions to be realized for the proven long-term benefit or improved quality of life for society.

ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible for nomination, a candidate must meet the following requirements:

- 1) Be a Canadian citizen;
- 2) Have carried out a major achievement in Manitoba;
- 3) Engineers, geoscientists, or non-engineers/geoscientists are eligible

NOMINATIONS/APPLICATIONS

The names of potential recipients for review by the Awards Committee shall be solicited from the members of the Association, including members of Council and Committees.

Names of potential recipients will normally be in the hands of the Awards Committee Chair by May 31 of each year.

Nominations for the Award will normally be made to Council by the Awards Committee prior to November 1 of each year.

The application submission presented must show large or significant engineering or geoscientific works or contributions by an individual engineer/geoscientist or teams of engineers/geoscientists requiring as a prerequisite, major commitments and approvals by others in decision-making roles who may or may not be engineers or geoscientists. These commitments should demonstrate a long-range vision, along with tremendous courage and conviction, sometimes with risk of personal sacrifices or loss of credibility in the short term in the eyes of peers or the public.

SELECTION CRITERIA

The Leadership Award will be judged on one or both of the following:

- 1) The magnitude and nature of the personal involvement in a major vision achievement.
- 2) The impact on society or quality of life of a major vision achievement.

This Award will be based on stringent merit considerations only. Although evaluations for an award will be made each year, it is expected that there will not be an individual recipient every year.

TIMING/PRESENTATION

The Leadership Award will be awarded during National Engineering Week in March, or at a meeting or portion of a meeting called for the purpose of presenting awards.
