## GENERAL INFORMATION

### Nominations

The names of potential recipients for review by the Awards Committee shall be solicited from the members of the Association, including members of Council and Committees.

Names of potential recipients will normally be in the hands of the Awards Committee by May 31 of each year.

Nominations for the Award will normally be made to Council by the Awards Committee prior to November 1 of each year.

### Eligibility

To be eligible for nomination, a candidate must meet the following requirements:

- 1) Be a Canadian citizen;
- 2) Be registered as a professional engineer or professional geoscientist in the Association of Professional Engineers and Geoscientists of the Province of Manitoba;
- 3) Have carried out major achievements in Manitoba.

### Guidelines

Merit for this award will be judged on one or more of:

- 1) A contribution to engineering or geoscience literature showing scholarly achievement;
- 2) The magnitude of engineering or geoscience works successfully completed;
- 3) The pioneering achievement in the field of engineering or geoscience application;
- 4) Outstanding public service.

### Requirements

Completion of the application form in full. All areas of questions must be answered in full and accompanied if necessary by additional attachments describing the work and achievements of the nominee which, in the opinion of the nominators, qualify the nominee for the award, together with such supporting evidence as they may wish the Awards Committee members to consider.

Additional attachments should be limited in length.

## **Selection Criteria**

- 1) ***Work Related Achievements*** - the practice of, the teaching of, and research into engineering or geoscience.
- 2) ***Service to the Profession*** - public education and understanding of the role of engineering and geoscience, professional engineers and professional geoscientists in Canadian society, active participation in engineering or geoscience associations, societies, institutes, etc.
- 3) ***Service to the Community*** - commission, voluntary organization, community organization.
- 4) ***Enhancement of the Quality of Life*** - improvement of the physical and/or social environment through engineering, geoscience and other works.

## **Administration**

The program is administered by the APEM Awards Committee. The Awards Committee has the authority after reviewing all applications for the Merit Award to determine whether or not to recommend the nomination of a candidate to Council.

At the discretion of the Awards Committee, nominations may be brought forward for consideration the following year.

### ***CONTRIBUTION TO ENGINEERING OR GEOSCIENCE LITERATURE SHOWING SCHOLARLY ACHIEVEMENT***

This section should include such areas as the practice of engineering or geoscience; the teaching of engineering or geoscience; the undertaking of engineering or geoscience research: other.

***MAGNITUDE OF ENGINEERING OR GEOSCIENCE WORKS  
SUCCESSFULLY COMPLETED.***

This section should include work related achievements including areas such as educating the public to understand better the role of engineering/geoscience and engineers/geoscientists in Canadian society; active participation in engineering or geoscience associations, societies, institutions, etc.; other.

***PIONEERING ACHIEVEMENTS IN THE FIELD OF ENGINEERING OR  
GEOSCIENCE APPLICATION.***

This section should include the enhancement of the quality of life; improvement of the physical and/or social environment thorough engineering/geoscience and other works.

***OUTSTANDING PUBLIC SERVICE***

This section should include areas such as volunteer work in the community, service clubs, charitable organizations; participation in commissions, boards, task forces, etc.; participation in government administration (municipal, provincial, federal) as an elected official; other.
