

LIFE MEMBERSHIP

In accordance with the conditions of By-law 31 of the Association, Life Membership, Honoris Causa, may be granted by unanimous decision of Council to a member who has, in the opinion of Council, rendered meritorious service to the Association, who is no longer practising on a full-time basis as a Professional Engineer, and who has preferably been continuously a member for not less than 35 years and has attained the age of 65.

David Samuel G. Ross was registered in this Association in June 1945. He became a member of the Advisory Committee in 1956 and remained on the Committee until 1963, serving for one year as Chairman. In 1961 Mr. Ross joined the Salary Committee and served as its Chairman from 1963 to 1967. From 1968 to 1971 he was a member of the Employee Engineers Committee, serving as its Chairman for three years.
