

HONORARY LIFE MEMBERSHIP

According to By-law 31 of the Association, Life Membership, Honoris Causa, may be granted by unanimous decision of Council to a member who has, in the opinion of Council, rendered meritorious service to the Association, who is no longer practising on a full-time basis as a Professional Engineer, and who has preferably been continuously a member for not less than 35 years and has attained the age of 65.
