As Chief Engineer of the Manitoba Water Services Board, Mr. Menon was instrumental in all phases of the Red River Regional Water Supply System project designed and implemented over the past five years.

This project is the first rural regional water supply system in Manitoba. It was conceptualized in its final form by Dick Menon and the M.W.S.B. staff in 1983. Under his management the Board negotiated, financed and administered the project. The engineering staff under his direct supervision was responsible for the design and administration during construction of many of the components of the project. In addition, Mr. Menon was responsible for the coordination of the engineering groups which designed and implemented the other components.

The system continues to be extended to this day, in response to the demands of rural residents who have been constrained by the availability of water for generations. To date, some six million dollars have been invested, over 150 kilometers of distribution piping installed and over 5000 people are served, including residents of one town, three villages, numerous hamlets and nearly 300 farms.

In consideration of the administrative complexity, the design innovation and the contribution of the project to the health and economic well being of thousands of Manitobans and for his key role in making the project a reality, Dick Menon is recognized for this engineering achievement.
