Ray McQuade was registered with this Association in 1952 and has been a continuous member for 44 years.

Ray served on the Management Committee of the Engineering Institute of Canada (EIC) for one year, the Bulletin Committee for six years, the Nominating Committee for one year, the Safety in Engineering Practice Committee for seven years, the Legislation Committee for four years, the University Liaison Committee for 17 years, the Ad Hoc Committee on the Code of Ethics for five years, the Committee on the Stamping of Shop Drawings for two years, the Practice and Ethics Committee for eight years and the Discipline Committee for five years - for a total of 56 committee years of service.
