Winnipeg is a city that is seeing substantial population growth and new development, as well as infill development and revitalization in the downtown and core area. The Transit Planner plays a key role in guiding the development of the city transportation services to meet the demand that comes with this growth by conducting service planning studies to improve the efficiency, effectiveness and coverage of transit service. This includes planning for new transit infrastructure (such as transit priority measures, bus stops, rapid transit facilities) and managing the implementation of new infrastructure and new/modified transit routes. Reviewing and providing technical input on development plans and major projects in order to ensure that transit service can be provided efficiently and conveniently to new developments is a very important part of the Transit Planner's role.

The Transit Planner makes use of many advanced analysis tools, such as geographic information systems (GIS), statistical analysis software and travel demand modelling. The Transit Planner supervises the development and maintenance of data needed for these tools, and facilitates the sharing of both data and the results of planning exercises between various City departments. The integration of transportation planning with land-use planning across City departments is vital, and the Transit Planner must be able to work effectively with other transportation engineers and urban planners.

The core of the Transit Planner's job is to develop 5-year transit service concept plans to accommodate ridership growth in existing areas and in newly developed or as-yet-undeveloped areas of the city. This position requires creative skills in the areas of engineering, urban planning, project management and resource allocation.

### **As the *Transit Planner* you will:**

- Develops plans to improve the efficiency and effectiveness of transit service and then implements those plans.
- Supervises the Transit Planning Assistant in the development and maintenance of Geographical Information Systems (GIS) to support transit planning.
- Manages the land-use and development monitoring program and provides input on development plans.
- Provides input from Winnipeg Transit for the City's medium and long-range transportation and land-use plans.
- Carries out transit infrastructure planning studies and manages project implementation

### **Your education and experience includes:**

- Bachelor's Degree - Civil Engineering (in some instances, a related degree in Urban Planning, Geography or Business Administration will be acceptable for candidates with extensive experience). A Master's Degree in Transportation Engineering or Planning is considered as asset.
- P. Eng. (APEGM) or MCIP (MPPI/CIP) designation is considered an asset.
- Progressive experience in the area of transportation planning, traffic engineering, urban planning and statistical analysis.
- Demonstrated ability to cooperate effectively with internal and external stakeholders, and negotiate agreements to achieve common goals.
- Strong interpersonal skills, including communication, both oral and written, public presentation and formal reporting capabilities, facilitation and collaboration.
- The ability to work collaboratively as part of a team, as well as lead project teams and direct peers.
- Progressive experience in the development and application of geographic information systems (GIS) and travel demand models (Visum).
