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TAKE NOTICE that the Investigation Committee of the Association of Professional Engineers and Geoscientists of the Province of Manitoba (“**EGM**”) formulates the following charge:

MORR Transportation Consulting Ltd. (“**MORR**”), while registered as a professional engineering firm and Certificate of Authorization holder in the Province of Manitoba, displayed conduct which constitutes professional misconduct or unskilled practice as described in sections 46(1)(a)(c)(d) and (e) of *The Engineering and Geoscientific Professions Act, C.C.S.M. c. E120* (the “**Act**”), in that:

1. In the course of providing engineering services respecting the preparation of a report dated March 2020, titled “Traffic and Pedestrian Study Waverley West School Site: Pembina Trails School Division” (the “**Report**”), MORR failed to ensure that Professional Engineers under its employ authenticated the Report despite having issued the Report to its client, and therefore contravened ss. 26(3) of the Act and contravened Part 3.2.1 of the *Authentication of Electronic and Hardcopy Documents Guideline (December 19, 2019)* (the “**Guideline**”); and
2. In the course of providing engineering services respecting the preparation of the Report, MORR failed to affix to the Report the stamp issued to it as a Certificate of Authorization holder, and therefore contravened ss. 26(6) of the Act, and contravened Part 4 of the Guideline.
