IMPORTANT

Applicants who meet the syllabus requirements will be deemed academically qualified, and therefore, are not required to complete exams (*See Step 2c*).

Start Here

Step 2: Academic Assessment

- a) Submit the Academic Assessment Application
 - Submit your required documents
 - Pay the assessment fee
- b) Receive your assessment results
- c) Complete your assigned exams
- d) Receive your Letter of Invitation from Engineers Geoscientists Manitoba

You will receive a letter of invitation from the Association.

Begin Step 4 while you wait for your ABC Test results

Step 3: Act, Bylaws, Code of Ethics (ABC) Test

- a) Schedule the ABC Test
- b) Pass the ABC Test

The Association can now process your Intern application.

The Association will prompt you to begin Steps 5 & 6 as you near completion of the Intern program

Step 4: Intern

- a) Submit the Intern application
 - Submit your required documents
 - Pay the Intern application fee
 - Pay the annual Intern dues
- b) Submit ongoing reports for:
 - 4 years of current work experience
 - Up to 48 hours of volunteer service
 - Up to 48 hours of professional development

Step 5: Professional Practice Exam

- a) Submit the exam application
 - Pay the exam fee
- b) Pass the exam

Step 6: Professional Member

- a) On request, provide the Association with three references
- b) On request, pay registration fee
- c) Your file will be forwarded to the Registration Committee for approval
