## Background

In 2002, when the Council of the Association of Professional Engineers and Geoscientists of the Province of Manitoba (APEGM) was seeking a way to support the building of the new Engineering and Information Technology Complex (EITC) at the University of Manitoba, they found that under the governing Act, there was very little the Association was permitted to do in terms of direct financial assistance. The Council therefore determined to work with a number of APEGM members in establishing a charitable foundation, and in 2003 the APEGM Foundation Inc. was born.

## Accomplishments

Since its founding, the APEGM Foundation has pledged and fully funded a contribution towards the capital building fund of the Engineering and Information Technology Complex (EITC) at the University of Manitoba. Other projects funded to date include contributions towards the upgrade of the Star Lake Field Station and the Centennial History Wall project for the Department of Geological Sciences, U of M; an upgrade to the Brandon University Geological Gallery; support for the production of the U of M Faculty of Engineering Centennial Book project; and, the purchase of books for the Donald W. Craik Engineering Library (APEGM Past Presidents Book Project).
