March 19, 2015 – Doug McNeil, P.Eng., is a registered Professional Engineer with the Association of Professional Engineers and Geoscientists of Manitoba. This is in response to the announcement by Mayor Brian Bowman on Wednesday that Doug McNeil, P.Eng., who most recently served as deputy minister in the province’s infrastructure and transportation department, was unanimously approved for recommendation by the CAO selection committee to be the city’s new chief administrative officer. The recommendation goes for approval by city council on March 25, 2015.
