Topic: **300 Cubits by 50 Cubits by 30 Cubits**

Abstract: Here we are late in Spring and we're preparing for yet another large flood – the third in five years. The latest Flood Outlook suggests a repeat of the 2009 flood on the Red River (larger than 2011) and a 1995 flood on the Assiniboine River (smaller than 2011 but not insignificant). The problem at this point in time is that the flood hasn't even started yet as we continue to see unseasonably cold temperatures. It's going to warm up soon and when it does maybe what we really need is an Ark. The presentation will highlight the 2013 flood forecasts, preparations and operations.

Speaker: Doug McNeil is Deputy Minister of Manitoba Infrastructure and Transportation and was awarded the 2012 APEGM Leadership Award for his role in the Province's 2011 flood fight.
