Experience Review Committee

The Experience Review Committee (ERC) is responsible for verifying the progress of Engineers in training and Geoscientists in training by reviewing progress reports which have been completed by both themselves and their supervisors. The ERC is made up of registered professionals from all engineering and geoscience disciplines.

General Duties and Responsibilities:

- Review interim reports provided by the applicant and provide feedback on work experience, and professional development, this is typically done online and training is provided.
- Participate in regular meetings with the Experience Review Committee to discuss GIT/EIT issues and policy development related to this committee.

Specific Skills and Qualifications

- Be a Professional Geoscientist (P.Geo.) in the area of “hard rock”, however those with ‘soft rock’ or hydrogeology will be considered.
- Be able to commit to reviewing files on a regular basis.
- Be available for meetings either in person or by teleconference

Time Commitment:

The committee meets every month (12 times a year) with the meetings running approximately 1-2 hours in length. Committee members are welcome to attend by teleconference. Attendance at every meeting, whether in person or by teleconference, is NOT mandatory (it is beneficial to try to attend as much as possible when you first join to familiarize yourself with the committee work).
