

STEPS FOR STUDENTS TO GAIN REGISTRATION



APPLY AS A STUDENT

Undergraduate students attending either the University of Manitoba, accepted into the Price Faculty of Engineering, or an undergraduate Geoscience student at either the University of Manitoba or Brandon University can apply to be a student with Engineers Geoscientists Manitoba (EngGeoMB).



LOG EXPERIENCE

Students enrolled with EngGeoMB have access to a work log document to track work experiences in the appropriate competency categories required for Competency-Based Assessment (CBA).



GATHER DOCUMENTS AND DOWNLOAD APPLICATION

Upon graduation with a four-year degree in engineering or geoscience, you would be eligible to apply for admission to become an Intern.
- Gather all necessary documents to submit with the application.



COMPLETE THE ACT, BY-LAWS AND CODE OF ETHICS (ABC) TEST

Confirmation will be received that you have become an Intern with EngGeoMB, along with an invitation to move forward to CBA.
