Don Spangelo became registered with this Association on June 13, 1983, and has been a member continuously for 20 years. Don graduated from the University of Manitoba with a B.Sc. in Civil Engineering in 1981.

Don served as a member of Council from 1995 – 1997. He also served on the Publication Committee for six years, the Legislation Committee (of which he is currently the Chair) for 14 years, the Discipline Committee (of which he continues to be a member) for ten years and the Issues Awareness Board for four years. This makes a total of thirty-seven committee-years of service.

In addition to those thirty-seven committee years of service Don Spangelo has contributed many hours of service as the leader and developer of the Association's testing program for the Spaghetti Bridge Building Competition that is part of the National Engineering Week activities. Don and his team have tested approximately 100 spaghetti bridges for school children in each year for the last ten years.
