The successful candidate will have a proven track record and bring with them an exceptional understanding of geotechnical engineering, soil mechanics and specialized geotechnical construction techniques. Excellent verbal and written communication skills will be imperative to work collaboratively and communicate effectively with other professionals, ministry employees, stakeholders, and the public.

You will be a competent user of computer software including databases, GIS and geospatial tools, and other applications related to geotechnical engineering. You will be results-oriented, an innovative and conceptual thinker and have demonstrated that you are an effective leader. Knowledge of highway design, construction, and maintenance practices will be an asset.

Located in Regina and working with the Materials and Surfacing Unit, you will be an integral member of the Design and Construction Division. You will be the provincial lead on geotechnical engineering and supervise geotechnical staff and the Regina aggregate team responsible for management of ministry-owned and operated gravel pits. You will be responsible for the provincial geohazards risk management program, provide expert advice on geotechnical issues, manage geotechnical standards, and champion new geotechnical initiatives for the Ministry.

You must be able to work in and create an environment that recognizes, supports, respects, and welcomes diversity of employees and clients. You will possess a valid Saskatchewan Driver's License and you will also be willing to travel independently throughout the province on field inspections. You will have the mobility to safely navigate over steep and uneven ground.

The knowledge, skills and abilities for this position would typically have been acquired through the completion of a Master's degree in geotechnical engineering, supplemented by several years of related experience. An equivalent combination of education and experience may be considered. You must be a professional engineer registered or be eligible for registration with the Association of Professional Engineers and Geoscientists of Saskatchewan.
