Academic Review Committee

The Academic Review Committee was established following the updates to academic criteria and assessment processes in the Manual of Admissions, which came into effect on July 1, 2025.

The Committee supports the Registrar/CEO by providing recommendations to the Registration Committee regarding whether first-time applicants for enrolment as interns meet academic qualification requirements.

Committee members represent a cross-section of academic disciplines and workplace sectors, including academic staff from Manitoba universities.

General Duties and Responsibilities:

- Review and recommend updates to academic eligibility requirements in the Manual of Admissions and within the Association's academic assessment program.
- Individually review academic assessments conducted by Admissions staff and determine whether applicants meet academic requirements or require a confirmatory program.
- Participate in the Committee's annual audit of the assessment program results.

Specific Skills and Qualifications:

- Registered as a P.Eng. in good standing with the Association.
- Compliant with ProDev requirements.

- Awareness of current academic requirements, practice standards, employer expectations, and workplace cultures in your engineering discipline.
- Ability to review files regularly and attend Committee meetings.

Time Commitment:

- The Committee meets monthly, either virtually or in person. Members are assigned files throughout the year based on discipline and are responsible for submitting assessments aligned with established guidelines and Engineers Canada knowledge requirements.
- Terms are three years, renewable once for an additional three-year term.
